Stay Safe This Winter: Winter Weather Safety Tips from The Roanoke Fire Department
As winter settles in, freezing temperatures, snow, and ice can create hazardous conditions at home and on the road. Your Roanoke Fire Department is here to share essential tips to keep you and your family safe during the colder months.

Heating Safety

- Space Heaters: Keep space heaters at least three feet away from anything that can burn, including furniture, bedding, and curtains. Always turn them off when leaving the room or going to sleep. Always plug them directly into an outlet, do not use a power strip or extension cord with space heaters.
- Fireplaces and Chimneys: Ensure fireplaces are clean and properly vented. Use a sturdy screen to catch sparks and prevent them from igniting nearby materials.

Prevent Carbon Monoxide Poisoning

- Install carbon monoxide detectors on every level of your home, especially near sleeping areas.
- Never use a generator, grill, or camp stove inside your home, garage, or near windows, as these can produce deadly carbon monoxide gas.

Emergency Preparedness

- Stay Informed: Monitor weather alerts and warnings to stay ahead of incoming storms.
- Create a Kit: Assemble an emergency kit with essentials such as water, non-perishable food, flashlights, batteries, and warm clothing.
- Plan for Power Outages: Have extra blankets and a battery-powered radio to stay warm and informed if the power goes out.

Snow and Ice Safety

- Clearing Snow: Shovel driveways and sidewalks carefully to prevent slips and falls. Take breaks to avoid overexertion.
- Driving Tips: Equip your vehicle with an emergency kit, including blankets, a flashlight, and sand or kitty litter for traction. Drive cautiously and allow extra time for travel.
