Conceptual Design - Actual May Vary

On Tuesday, February 11, 2025, Roanoke City Council voted unanimously to call a Bond Election on May 3, 2025. Residents will vote on a proposed \$62 million bond for a convention center project. While the convention center is the only project piece that would require voter approval, the comprehensive project includes a boutique hotel and parking structure in the vacant space east of City Hall. Early voting April 22-29. Election May 3.


