**Utility Rate Adjustment**

Roanoke Water Utilities is sharing information about a planned sewer rate adjustment coming in January 2026 following a comprehensive review by our consulting firm, NewGen Strategies.

**Rate Adjustment Breakdown**

The adjustment, recommended after a thorough rate study by NewGen Strategies, will vary based on individual usage. The average residential customer using 5,000 gallons of water per month can expect to see an increase of approximately \$14.10.

This change is necessary due to increased pass-through rates from the Trinity River Authority and City of Fort Worth wholesale water.
